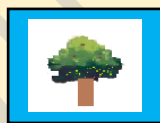


Explanation:

Living things:

- Dog: It can move, grow, breathe, and reproduce.
- Tree: It grows, reproduces (through seeds), and responds to its environment.
- Fish: They swim, breathe underwater, grow, and reproduce.

Non-living things:

- Chair: It does not grow, reproduce, or respond to its environment in the same way living things do.

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- Cloud: It is formed from water vapor and does not have characteristics of living organisms.
 - Rock: It is a solid mineral material and does not exhibit characteristics of life.
