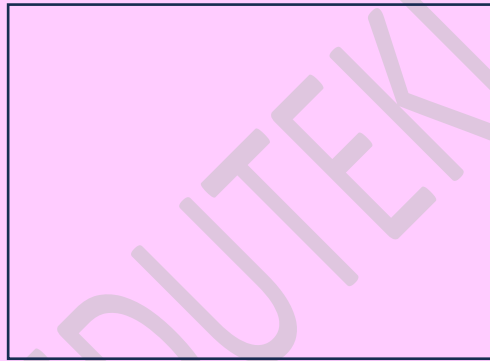

1. Draw a simple plant in the box below.

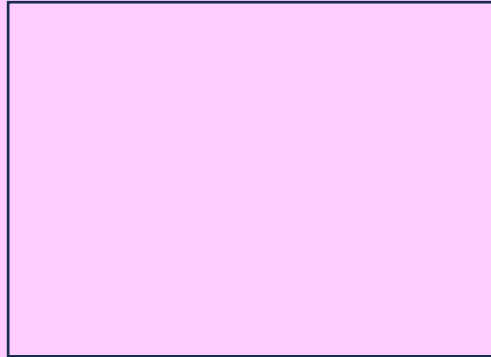


2. Label the parts of the plant: **roots**, **stem**, **leaves**, and **flower**.
